In RE we will be learning about caring for others. We will be thinking about harvest and encouraging the children to reflect on why it is important to share food with others less fortunate.

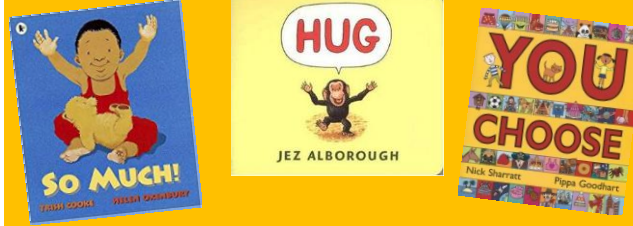


Physical Development
